Spotlight on Programs

What a difference this past year has made in terms of us being able to reinstate most of our original programs and launch some exciting new options. We continued to provide a hybrid of in-person and virtual programs, as so many of our participants appreciated being able to attend sessions from home if they're feeling unwell or to drop into the centre when they want to personally connect with each other. Here's what was New in 2023!

- Art Journaling is a program where participants create a personal 'art journal' while sharing their experiences in a safe, non-judgmental environment.
- •Art Expression workshops are held 4 times per year in conjunction with the changing seasons.
- Souper Tuesdays are lunch and learn informational sessions led by a registered Physiotherapist, and held six times per year.
- Just Show Up Interactive Connections is now in it's second 8-week session. It's a weekly program for children ages 6 to 14 years old who have a parent, guardian or grandparent impacted by a cancer diagnosis.

- Circle of Sharing Breast Reconstruction Support Group is a unique service that helps women who have undergone breast reconstruction, reclaim a sense of wholeness.
- Garden Club workshops were held twice in 2023, both times enabling members to create seasonal centrepieces while enjoying a fun and supportive afternoon.
- Our Nourish Program was reinstated in 2023 with seven different workshops covering a variety of topics pertaining to food/nutrition and cancer. Sessions are led by a qualified dietician.

Productive Partnerships

Wellspring London and Region was very active with our research partners in 2023. In collaboration with Kings College (Western University) we presented our research titled 'Narratives of the cancer journey: Fostering resilience, at two separate National conferences.'

Wellspring staff, members, volunteers and stakeholders also participated in phase two of the 'Experiences of hope, self-compassion and authentic collaboration: Foundations for a consumer-informed compassion-based HS delivery framework in a Canadian Context', working closely together with our partners from Humber College. We are the only cancer organization represented in this study of eight organizations across Canada.

- We continued to have success in numbers attending all online programs (including meditation, evening yoga, afternoon yoga, and chair yoga) with members from Stratford and London participating online. Meditation and chair yoga are now hybrid programs where members have the choice to attend online or can come in to the center to join the class with others.
- Due to popular demand, we expanded our Reiki program to include a second afternoon each week.
- In conjunction with Wellspring London, our Souper Tuesdays have been a fabulous success. Special thanks to our program sponsors who provide our members with bowls of delicious soup and baked goods to enjoy while they tune in to listen to the information provided on different topics relating to cancer.
- A new Poetry Workshop was held three times in 2023 and has proved to be a very powerful program, giving participants an opportunity to creatively express their emotions through words.
- Our Annual BBQ Fundraiser at the Mountain Estate was another great success. Many thanks to David and Lenora Mountain for once again hosting this fun (and delicious) event!



- Our 16th annual Golf Tournament was held at River Valley Golf Course on September 14th, and was another super successful year, thanks to our golfers, hole and silent auction sponsors.
- In late October we held a Community Engagement event at Jobsite Brewery with approximately 75 people in attendance. Guests were able to learn more about Wellspring Stratford and the various opportunities available to help support our Centre and the programs we offer.
